Beloved in Christ, Looking way ahead to November 7th, there will likely be a proposed Ohio Constitutional Amendment on the ballot to enshrine the right to kill unborn children in Ohio's Constitution. Smart people who analyze such things say the deliberate wording of the amendment would also cause parents to lose consent for their children receiving mutilating treatments to their bodies. The bishops of Ohio have reminded us: "As Catholics, we cannot remain on the sidelines when confronted with such a clear threat to human life." For these reasons, we are reminded to register to vote in order to fulfill our civic duty and vote NO in November. We will hear more about this over the next couple of months. Please see ohiocathconf.org/protect-ohio for more information including a link to Project Rachel for those who seek healing from the effects of past abortions. May they experience the healing touch of Jesus...

Looking a little ahead to August 8th, next week, a special election will take place in Ohio to vote on Issue 1, which asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters on the proposed amendment." Following is a statement from our bishops: "The bishops of Ohio are not taking a position on this issue because it does not contain any direct moral content. While pastors and parish workers should also remain publicly neutral on this issue, it is important to give non-partisan information intended to help the voter understand what is at stake. It is therefore acceptable to pass along this information: Issue 1 will increase the threshold required for any proposed amendment to the Constitution of Ohio from a simple majority vote to at least a 60% majority vote in order to pass. Therefore, a "yes" vote on issue 1 will make it more difficult to pass any future amendment to the Constitution of Ohio, including this November's ballot initiative seeking an abortion rights constitutional amendment that expands and enshrines abortion at the expense of protections of preborn children and women. A "no" vote on issue 1 will maintain the current threshold, making it easier to pass an amendment to Ohio's constitution, including the one coming this November on the abortion expansion amendment." 

Keep an eye out for activity alerts around the last week of the month for HC work parties. Come out and help, no experience necessary and training is provided. Many hands make light the work. The Home Corp raffle which is HCs only fundraiser is underway, Tickets are \$10 ea, and there are 3 prizes per month, \$40, \$25, and \$10. Only 200 tickets were printed. Tickets will be drawn every 3rd Thursday until May. Each ticket drawn goes back in the barrel for subsequent draws. See HC President PGK Frank Minnick to purchase a ticket.

2023 Football Frenzy

My brother knights, as always at this time of year the Ohio State Council K of C kicks off the Football Frenzy. This is the 20th year for this particular fundraiser. All the money raised goes to various charities at the state and council level, it does not go to the NFL. The Football Frenzy involves the last 10 weeks of games played this season – games that will be played between late October through December/January. Donation is \$20.00 per ticket. The turn in deadline for the full season of games is Nov 2, 2023. Late turn in will be allowed up to Dec 31, 2023, however any tickets turned in after Nov 2 only count for the remaining games and are not retroactive. Last year 3724 sold 74 tickets which netted the council a \$407.00 rebate, and since we did not achieve a minimum quota, the council had to pay \$ 1,076 in State Per Capita. The state has made some changes to the program this year which should enable us to get some relief. These goals are achievable with your support.

- Sell 135 tickets 3724 receives 100% per capita credit and a \$9.00 rebate for each ticket.
- Sell 90 tickets 3724 receives 75% per capita credit and a \$8.00 rebate for each ticket.
- Sell 68 tickets 3724 received 50% per capita credit and a \$7.00 rebate for each ticket.
- Sell 45 tickets 3724 receives 25% per capita credit and a \$6.50 rebate for each ticket.

I am asking all brothers to be responsible for 2 tickets, buy one, sell one, buy two or sell two and we can achieve our GK's goal. Tickets are being mailed out to all members or can be picked up and turned in at the council hall beginning Thursday Aug 3. Please make checks payable to: **K of C 3724**

Fairborn 3724 Knight & United States Coast Guard (USCG) Intelligence Specialist Second Class Lyndon Engle has completed his assignment at the National Geospatial Intelligence Agency (NGIA) in Washington, DC. He recently received Commendation Awards for his Special Assignment in Miami Florida and for his performance at NGIA. During late July 2023, E5 Petty Officer Engle reported to his new assignment aboard the USCG Cutter TAMPA, which is homeported in Portsmouth, VA. The TAMPA regularly executes a variety of Coast Guard missions, to include Drug Interdiction, Search and Rescue, Living Marine Resources, and Migrant Interdiction. The TAMPA normally deploys for two to three months, followed by similar in-port periods & routinely patrols in many exciting locations, including the Caribbean, Eastern Pacific, and Eastern Seaboard.
