



Past Grand Knight, Sir Knight John F. Maiorano passed away peacefully on Thursday May 18, 2023 at the age of 87. Brother John is survived by his wife of 64-years, Carol. John loved to teach and was an adjunct professor at the University of Dayton and a tutor for illiterate adults. When he retired from civil service, he became heavily involved at Mary Help of Christians parish, including serving as the business manager, as the lector on the bereavement committee, and with bible study classes. John also was active with St. Vincent de Paul and the Knights of Columbus.

Brother John entered the Knights of Columbus on June 1, 1960 and reentered on July 1, 1979 making him an Honorary Life Member. He received his 4th Degree on March 10, 2002. John was deeply involved in all activities and programs of the Fairborn Council for many years. He served as Grand Knight in the 2004-2005 Fraternal Year. He was named Knight of the Year in 2010-2011. In 2014, Brother John was the Blue Coat Awards Volunteer of the Year and subsequently the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Volunteer of the Year. To recognize his continued contributions, he was named Knight of the Month on numerous occasions and along with Carol were Family of the Month multiple times. Brother John Co-Chaired the Blue Coat Awards for several years with PGK John Wolfe and provided the Invocation at these events. Our Brother Knight was always helping out members and their families including bringing Communion to Sallie Wolfe during her illness and transporting Brother Gilbert Jenschke to treatment visits.

A lover of history and biblical scripture, it was always riveting to hear Brother John give talks and teach bible study. John represented all that is the Knights of Columbus. John now joins our many departed Brother Knights with our respect and thanks,


